Kyk regs en dan na links om te kyk vir aan komende verkeer.

Indien daar 'n voertuig aankom, wag totdat die voertuig verby is en kruis dan die pad

Pay Attention – Listen / Gee aandag—Luister

Teach your kids that they may not always be able to see an oncoming vehicle, especially if they are standing near a bend. Therefore, they should listen to know if a vehicle is approach- ing. Cars and other vehicles on the road often use the “horn” at bends and at unmanned in- tersections to indicate that they are nearing. Tell your children:

If they hear a horn, stop and look to the left and right to see if any vehicle is approaching.

Listen for engine sounds nearby to know if there is a moving vehicle – explain how a loud noise indicates the vehicle is nearby, and a faint sound means it is away.

Leer jou kinders dat hulle nie altyd 'n aankomende voertuig gaan sien nie, veral as hulle naby 'n draai staan. Voertuie gebruik dikwels die toeter as waarskuwing om aan te dui dat hulle naby is.

Vertel jou kinders:

Indien hulle 'n toeter hoor, om te stop en te kyk na links en regs om te sien of daar enige verkeer aankom.

Luister na motor masjien geluide en of daar 'n bewegende voertuig naby is—verduidelik dat 'n harde geluid toon dat die voertuig naby is en 'n dowwe geluid daarop dat die voertuig steeds ver is.

Don't Run On Roads / Moenie hard- loop op die pad nie

Children may not always have patience and may tend to run across the street to get to the other side. They may also run along the road in your neighborhood while playing. Tell your kids never to run across or along the road. Children can get distracted easily and leave their guardian's hand to run or sprint away.

Teach your kids to stay calm on the road and never to run or sprint.

Leer hulle om kalm te bly en nooit oor die pad te hardloop nie.

Rules To Ensure Road Safety For Kids / Reëls om padveilig vir kinders te verseker

Know Your Signals

Help your kid learn about the traffic lights and signs, and what each color indicates.

Green means 'go': Only when the signal turns 'green', vehicles move ahead.

Red means to 'stop': When the signal turns red, all the vehicles have to stop.

Yellow means to slow down: When the signal turns yellow, vehicles should slow down and prepare to stop.

Groen beteken "gaan": Slegs wanneer die lig groen slaan mag voertuie voort beweeg.

Rooi beteken "Stop": Wanneer die verkeerslig rooi slaan beteken dit dat alle voertuie moet stop.

Geel/Oranje beteken "verminder spoed": Wanneer die verkeerslig geel/oranje slaan beteken dit voertuie moet spoed verminder om voorbereid te wees om te stop.

The 'Walk' or a walking man symbol at intersections are for pedestrians. Cross the road only if these signs turn green. But look to the left and right to ensure no vehicles are approaching.

Never cross the road if the sign says 'Don't Walk' or if the walking man symbol turns red.

Sometimes a hand symbol is used instead of the walking man or 'Walk' signals. Tell your kid about that too. If there are other symbols for pedestrians, you should make it a point to let them know. Gradually, teach your children about the other essential traffic signals they should know.

Die "stap" of mannetjie wat stap simbool by interseksies is vir voetgangers. Wanneer hierdie mannetjie groen slaan mag jy stap. Andersins as daar nie so 'n verkeerslig is met die genoemde mannetjie nie, kyk na links en regs vir aankomende verkeer alvorens jy die pad oorsteek. Moet nooit die pad oorsteek as die mannetjie rooi slaan nie. Party maal word 'n hand simbool gebruik, vertel u kind ook daarvan. Indien daar enige ander simboel vir padverbruikers is, maak u kind bewus daarvan. Leer u kind stelselmatig van ander belangrike verkeers tekens waarvan hulle moet kennis dra.

Stop, Look, And Cross

Your child may have to walk to school or the bus stop and back. They may only have to cross the street after the school bus drops them off. Even if they don't, they may have to cross the street to get to a friend's house or a neighbor's. Whatever the case is, you should teach your kids to cross the road safely. Here's how you can help them learn.

Always look for signals and use the pedestrian crossing to cross the road. In the absence of such markings, here is what you should do:

Look to your right and then to the left to see if there are any approaching vehicles.

If yes, wait for the vehicle to pass and then cross the road.

Never cross at bends.

Never cross between stationary vehicles.

Adults should always accompany children aged less than six and hold their hand when crossing the street.
